- Sun awning from mast to backstay, with removable sides

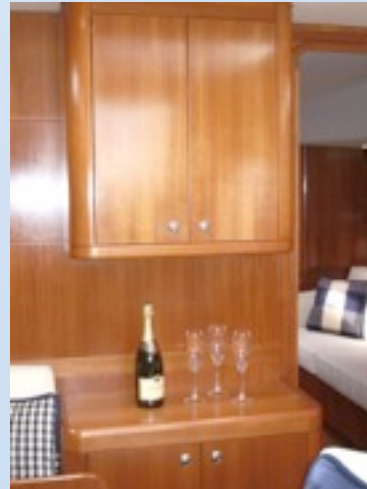

Cabins and Heads

Forward Cabins

- Skipper's cabin forward with wash basin and two berths
- Custom Owner's cabin forward, with double berth on port side, vanity desk against aft bulkhead, mast locker, sofa with two armrests, hanging lockers
- Large head/shower forward with large overhead shower rose



Aft Cabins

- Standard aft cabin port side with double berth and hanging lockers
- Additional aft cabin starboard side, with double berth and hanging locker
- Small head / wet room in Saloon with small overhead shower hose
